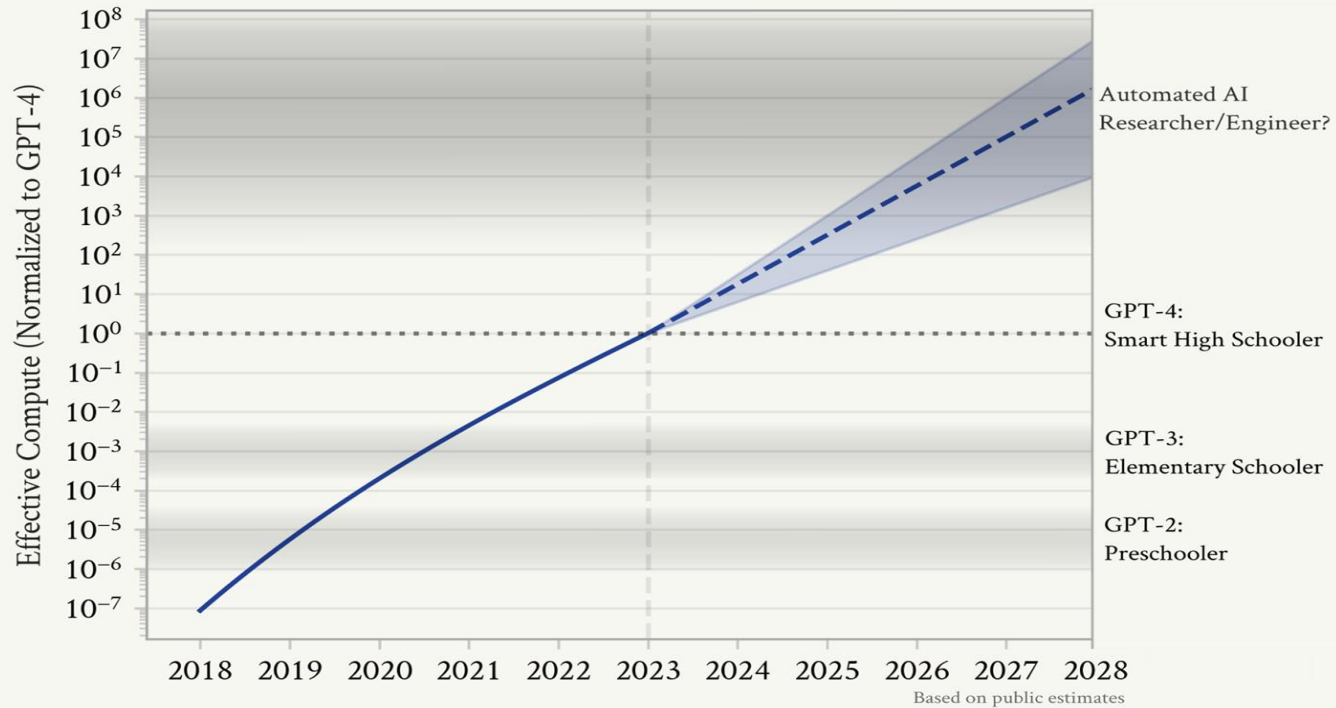

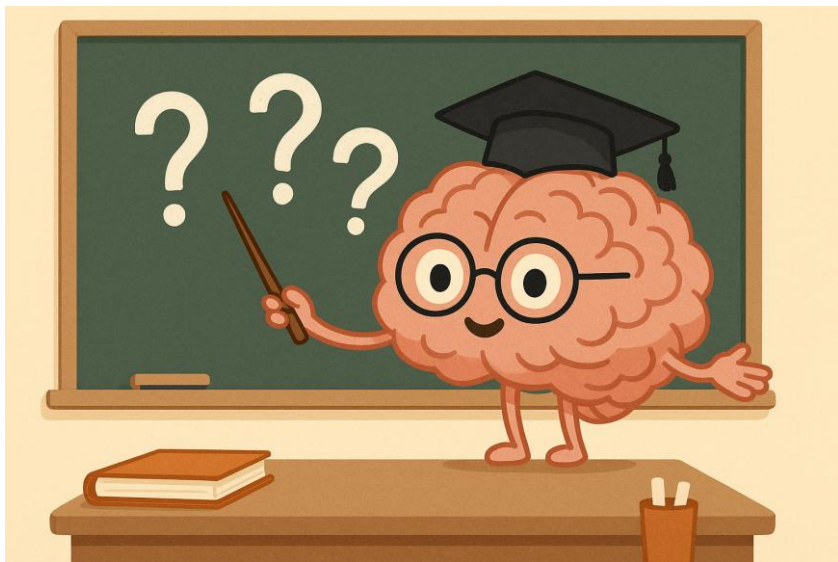
## Base Scaleup of Effective Compute

As time has progressed, with the advent of GPT 4o, the quality of the AI's analysis has improved markedly.

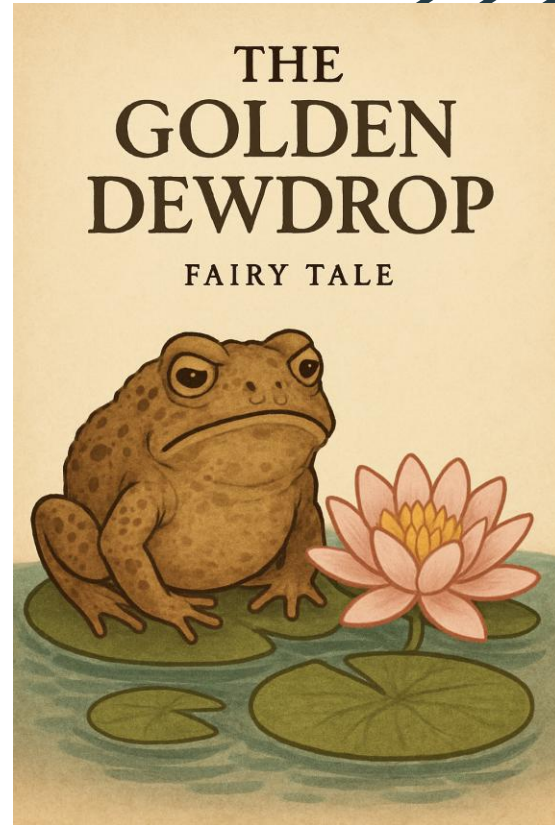




Lately, I've stepped outside of my teaching to begin using the power of the AI in a variety of ways. For example, I asked it to help us write our ["W&W" club constitution](#).
